Day 1

Arrival to Valtice, Czech Republic during the evening.

The Lednice-Valtice Area, cultural-natural complex is registered in the list of monuments protected as World Heritage by <u>UNESCO</u>. At the end of the 18th century, the local manor lordship - the <u>House of Liechtenstein</u> - began to create a unique manmade landscape complex - The <u>Lednice</u> - <u>Valtice</u> Area. During the 19th century, the Liechtenstein family continued transforming the area, which has since been called the "Garden of Europe", into a large <u>landscape park</u> with two centers: Valtice and Lednice castles with their contiguous villages. The Garden of Europe spreads in the warmest place of the Czech Republic area close to <u>Mikulov</u> town. This part of land is full of architectural jewels, romantic nooks, unique nature reserves, beautiful place for many activities especially during tourist season.

Day 2

Visiting the Valtice Castle, Museum of torture instruments and walking in the area of the Trail for bare feet with great views of Pálava region. It is a landscape protected area and UNESCO biosphere reserve since 1986. It is the warmest and almost the most arid area in the Czech Republic, and therefore vines are cultivated here. In the end of the day we will visit Museum of Iron Curtain.


Day 4
